POLICY DOCUMENT ON UNDERGRADUATE (UG) AND **POST GRADUATE (PG) ADMISSION**

I. UG Admission:

1. Introduction

In Maulana Azad College, online UG admission process first commenced in 2018 through the concerned Government notification followed by Calcutta University's guideline. Since then admission to Semester wise Three-Year B.A./B.Sc./ B.Com stream under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) was conducted through online mode till 2022. From 2023, as per circulars (Notification No CSR/05/2023 and Notification No CSR/04/2023 framed by Calcutta University), online admission started for Semester wise Four-Year B.A./ B.Sc./B.Com courses (Honours with or without Research) and Semester wise Three-Year B.A. Multidisciplinary courses of under Curriculum And Credit Framework (CCF, 2022). In 2024, instead of stand-alone college portal, admission is being carried out through Centralised Admission Portal operated by the West Bengal State Council of Higher Education as per Govt notification (Notification No 265 Edn (CS)/OM-102L/2022 dated 24th April, 2023).

2. Admission Committee: Admission is conducted by the Admission Committee, comprising of teachers and all Heads of the Departments, selected in a Teachers' Council meeting at the beginning of each academic session. The Committee places a report before the Teachers' Council after completion of the admission.

3. Courses Offered:

The college offers Majors in 20 subjects for the semester wise 4-year B.A./B.SC./ B.Com.(Honours with or without Research) courses (under CCF). A candidate will have to choose any one of the following 20 subjects as Major:

6. RESERVATION POLICY:

Reservation of seats for admission in different categories is followed by the concerned government order No 07-Edn (U) / 1U-89/13 dated 2nd January, 2014. This order typically outlines the reservation quotas for different categories such as Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC), and economically weaker sections (EWS). The percentage of reserved seats with respect to totals seats are SC: 22%, ST: 6%, OBC-A: 10%, OBC-B: 7% and EWS: 10%. Maximum 5% seats of all these categories and unreserved category too are reserved for persons with disabilities (PWD) candidates.

7. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The entire admission process is smoothly carried out following a two-step process as described below.

Step-1: ONLINE APPLICATION SUBMISSION DURING THE PRESCRIBED PERIOD:

Candidates are directed to visit the College Website www.maulanaazadcollegekolkata.ac.in to click on the admission portal. Next they are to create their own profile as per format and with their Registered Mobile Number (RMN) and Email as mandatory fields. After creating their profile, they may apply for as many subjects as they wish provided all sorts of eligibility criteria are fulfilled.

STEP-2: ON-LINE ADMISSION PROCEDURE DURING THE PRESCRIBED PERIOD:

After the online application part is over, course wise and category wise provisional merit lists are published on the college website. Candidates can lodge complaint through email only, within specified date and time, if they find any error in the merit lists. After reviewing their complaints, corrected merit list is published on the website if required. Admission lists are published from final merit list one by one till the vacancy exists in any category. Dereservation of vacant seats, if required, is done following rules and regulations framed by Governments for this purpose. Payment of Admission Fees is made online by via Debit Card, Credit Card, Net Banking etc. Once the payment is successful, provisional admission to that subject is complete subject to the verification of original documents.

During online admission process:

- 1. No candidates /guardians are allowed to be present physically in the college premises.
- 2. Provisionally admitted students are asked to submit required documents for verification. Failing to provide testimonials for verification may be liable to cancellation of admission.

II. PG Admission:

1. Introduction:

PG admission in different courses under CBCS is conducted through University admission portal. Candidates, fulfilling eligibility criteria as framed by the University of Calcutta, apply online through University admission portal. 80% of seats for each course are filled by the candidates who pursued their UG course under Calcutta University (CU candidates). The rest 20% of seats are allotted to the candidates who are not from colleges affiliated to Calcutta University (Non-CU candidates).

2. Courses Offered: English, Urdu and Zoology.

3. Eligibility Criteria & Selection Procedure

The eligibility criteria and selection procedure for admission to the Post Graduate Courses of Urdu, English and Zoology, offered by the College, follows the University norms and the entire admission process is conducted centrally by the University of Calcutta.

1. Admission Cancellation procedure

Cancellation of admission is finalized through an OTP, candidates receive on their registered mobile no. No request for cancellation of admission through email or any offline request is entertained.

2. Refund of Admission Fee

This requires submission of written application in person to the Principal, Maulana Azad College within stipulated period of time as notified.
