Dasgupta, Programme Coordinator, Maulana Azad College, 8, Rafi Ahmed Kidwai Road, Kolkata-700013, West Bengal will be the coordinator for this programme and will submit utilization certificate and statement of expenditure duly signed by him, finance/accounts officer of college and head of college in duplicate at the end of financial year.
- The college is required to implement the programme as per the terms and conditions given in **Annexure-I**.
- As per "Rule 236 (1) of GFR 2017", the Account of all Grantee Institution or Organisations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the institute or Organisation is called upon to do so.
- Non-recurring grant shall be utilized within 18 months of their release.
- The institute/agency will keep the whole of the grant in a bank account earning interest, and the interest so earned should be reported to DBT in the utilization certificate and statement of expenditure. The interest so earned will be treated as a credit to the institute/agency and shall be adjusted towards further installment of the grant and/or at the time of final settlement of accounts.
