Policy Document on Research and Development

Introduction:

The Maulana Azad College, one of the premier colleges in eastern India, affiliated to Calcutta University, nurtures a tradition of holistic education and learning amongst its students beyond textbook inculcating the components of innovation, development of research aptitude and social outreach. In recognition of its untiring effort towards this mission, the college was recognised as a Centre for Potential of Excellence by the University Grants Commission in 2010 and as a STAR College by the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Human Resource and Development, Govt. of India in 2017 to promote and foster student research. Presently, the National Education Policy (NEP), 2020 has mandated the inclusion of student research as an integral component of the Higher Education System with a strong emphasis on research, innovation and technology development to strengthen the foundation of Atma-Nirbhar Bharat (Self-reliant India). In accordance to the guidelines of establishment of research and development Cell in Higher Education Institutes as laid down by University Grants Commission under the framework of NEP, 2020, the Research Advisory Council of the college has been constituted. Four separate subcommittees function under the jurisdiction of the Research Advisory Council, namely 1) Finance and Infrastructure 2) Research Program and Policy Development 3) Collaboration and Community and 4) IPR, Legal and ethical matters. The functioning of the Council is governed by a set of policies as elaborated below approved by Co-ordinator, Internal Quality Assurance Cell and Principal, Maulana Azad College.

Objectives:

- Nurture and inculcate research philosophy amongst students through engagement of students in short term research projects, organization of workshops and hands-on-training programmes, peer-talk lecture series as well as student seminars.
- Promote innovation and enterprise amongst the student community for technology development with a simultaneous development of awareness regarding Intellectual Property Rights.
- Promote and augment industry-academia interface for providing a greater exposure and job opportunity to students
- Foster a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship and develop an ambience for startup activities in the college.
- Enhance research capacity and output through collaboration with Universities and Research institutions to augment research infrastructure and elevate the quality of research.
- Promote Social outreach and community services through research programmes.

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Policy for Finance and Infrastructure Sub-Committee

- The Finance and Infrastructure Subcommittee will ensure financial management, sustainability and growth of the institution keeping in mind the primary objective of instilling in students the philosophy and ambience of research.
- The committee will assist and advise Principal investigators during preparation of budget allocation components for extramural grant applications.
- The committee will oversee the purchase of both consumables and non-consumables sanctioned in the project. However, the decision of the PI will be given a high priority for purchase of specific consumables/instruments related to the implementation of a project.
- The Committee will write proposals to the Government time-to-time seeking funding for purchase of consumables and instruments as well as repairing of key instruments and other related infrastructure.
- The Committee will assist the PI in preparation of the utilization certificate duly certified by the Auditor.

Policy for Research Program Development

- The Committee shall take initiative time to time to appraise the full-time faculty members regarding the different funding agencies of the country and their criteria for funding research projects throughout the year in the different disciplines of Science, Social Science, Language and Humanities. It will also lend all assistance (if needed) in writing the research proposals including plagiarism checking of the final research proposal before submission. In this regard, the committee also spread awareness amongst the faculty members of the science disciplines regarding the project opportunities and other research schemes offered by Indiabioscience.org, an initiative of DBT to promote research among young faculty members.
- Since the college is under the academic and administrative jurisdiction of the University of Calcutta, it does not have a Ph.D. committee of its own. However, the committee will lend the assistance needed by faculty members to register themselves as Ph.D. supervisors at a suitable department under a University commensurate with their discipline of research and also mediate potential collaboration of the concerned teacher of the college with a faculty member from the University who may act as Co-supervisor of the research fellow recruited in the project.
- Recruitment of the fellow in the project (if available) will be strictly governed by the UGC rules and regulations for appointment of research fellow (a minimum of 55% marks at the Masters or Equivalent level with NET/GATE as desirable additional qualification as per the guidelines set by the funding agency. The advertisement regarding recruitment of the project fellow will be published well in advance in print/electronic media as well as in the college website. Recruitment of the fellow will be carried out through the constitution of an interview board duly approved by the funding agency.
- The committee will also monitor proposals received for summer/winter internships for short terms (1.5 to 2 months) from students of other institutions at the college laboratories under the supervision of the faculty members of the college

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Policy Document for Collaboration and Community

- The committee will foster a culture of collaboration and inclusivity, and take active strives towards development of community feeling both within the campus as well as in the localities in the vicinity of the college
- The committee will initiate Memorandum of Understandings with Universities, Institutions, NGOs and Industries to cater for the academic needs of students and faculty members, initiate job-oriented skill based and value-added certificate courses and explore and mediate internship opportunities of the students in industries and institutions.
- The committee will also organize from time-to-time societal outreach programmes in the local community and popular science workshops/laboratory visits for school children.

Policy Document for IPR, Legal and Ethical Matters

- The primary responsibility of the committee will be to promote awareness about Intellectual Property Rights, ethical conduct and compliance amongst the faculty members as well as the students of Maulana Azad College.
- The committee will also take adequate measures for creation of an incubation hub at the college
 and organize training sessions and workshops by experts both for students and faculty members
 regarding all stages of the development of a prototype starting from ideation to patent filing.
- The committee will also establish liaison with the Patent office regarding filing a patent for a newly developed design/prototype in the college and mediate the necessary legal procedures thereafter.
- The committee will also be responsible for formation of the necessary ethical committees (animal/human) for conducting research experimentations.
- The committee will also arrange lectures periodically to promote IPR and its necessity for students and faculty members.

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Sustainable Practices: Encouraging student linkage with industry/institute and providing research exposure for higher studies and career options"

Maulana Azad College is dedicated to the academic excellence of students. Its intended outcome is to:

- Provide industry/institute exposure to students right from the college level through educational tours/ excursions/ field-trips so that they have first-hand experience of the practical aspects of the subject.
- Make students aware of the latest trends in the world of research by regularly organising seminars/ symposia/ conferences/ workshops.
- Encourage students to attend similar events at other institutions and accompany them whenever required.
- Offer students career options and/or ideas for further studies and research, thereby giving them a headstart at an early stage.
- Creating a sound academic environment in the college in the best interest of the students.

If we consider this in the context of Indian Higher Education, we find that education nowadays places a lot of emphasis on co-curricular and extra-curricular activities in addition to the prescribed syllabus. Its importance is gauged from the fact that the National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) too has included hands-on learning in the form of 'Internship' for all students. This is because acquiring real-life experience can supplement the theoretical knowledge gained by students in the classroom. In view of the ever-increasing competition, be it in the arena of higher studies or jobs, the interface between academia and industry/institute has assumed paramount importance. The terms 'industry' and 'institute' have been used here in a broader sense to include all types of public and private concerns, viz. companies,

factories, workshops, institutes and organisations, and other places of academic interest.

The college has been playing the role of such a catalyst for long, with the active involvement of the head of the institution, departmental teachers and IQAC through the following ways:


- Offering students exposure to latest trends in research by organising national and international seminars / symposia / conferences / workshops where reputed scholars are invited as resource persons; during the period 2018-23, Maulana Azad College has conducted close to seventy such events.
- Majority of the departments arrange educational tours to places near and far, ranging from those in
 and around the city of Kolkata to distant venues like Darjeeling and Dooars in north Bengal and
 even outside the state of West Bengal, viz. Pench in Madhya Pradesh. Some of these visits are part
 of the curriculum of different subjects, namely Botany, History, Microbiology, Sociology and
 Zoology.
- Along with the above, many other departments like Bengali, Chemistry, Economics, English, Islamic History and Culture, Philosophy, Physics and Political Science have also taken the initiative to organise educational tours on their own, irrespective of the fact that such excursions



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- Teachers regularly encourage students to participate in events conducted by other institutions, be it local, state or national-level. They inform them about these events in the classroom as well as via social media platforms like WhatsApp groups and departmental pages on Facebook.
- Language departments like English, Persian and Urdu encourage their students to participate in programmes organised by reputed organisations like Goethe-Institut Kolkata, United States-India Educational Foundation (USIEF), Iran Society, Muslim Institute, West Bengal Urdu Academy, etc.
- Regular mentoring is carried out by teachers so that students are motivated to attend these
 programmes. Very often, teachers accompany the participating students to the venue for moral
 support and/or on-the-spot advice. While such field-trips are more common in the Science
 Departments, the Arts departments also conduct educational tours for experiential learning. These
 visits add substantially to conventional classroom studies and equip students with confidence to
 perform in real-life situations.
- Some teachers of the college are also supervisors for Ph.D. programmes, inspiring their students to take up research at a subsequent stage.
- Teachers of the college thus act as intermediaries and facilitate interaction between students and industry/institute through multiple channels, leading to a holistic cultivation of knowledge. Their involvement in guiding students in deciding their future career goals is thereby of paramount importance.

These initiatives on the part of the various departments have borne fruit, evinced in the academic performance of students in their University examinations and their subsequent progression.

- Close to 1100 students have progressed to higher education, be it post-graduate or professional courses from 2018-2023. It is also heartening to note that around 250 students have cracked competitive exams like CUET PG, JAM, GATE, IELTS, UGC-NET, CSIR-NET, etc. during this period.
- The placement of students in public or private sectors presents a satisfactory picture, considering the challenges in getting employment in current times, and almost 200 of them have been offered jobs in the course of this period.
- Around 120 students have benefitted from guidance for cracking competitive exams and a similar number have been given career counselling by their respective departments through formal counselling sessions. This is in addition to tips provided by the faculty members in an informal manner.
- More than 200 students have benefitted from counselling offered by their departmental teachers Owing to the above, Maulana Azad College consistently figures as a sought-after destination for students at the time of admission. It was placed at the 26th place in the country and 4th spot in West Bengal in the EW India Higher Education Ranking 2020, a nation-wide survey of best non-autonomous colleges conducted by EducationWorld magazine in its report published in April 2020. The next year, the college improved its showing and was placed 19th in the country and 3rd in the state in the same survey published in May 2021.





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However, a few problems were encountered while implementing this practice. The above-mentioned initiatives are usually taken by the teachers on their own under the aegis of the respective Heads of Department. Since there is no specific fund allotted for educational tours, teachers have to arrange for the expenditure (travel, registration, etc.) incurred in the course of these industry / institute visits either from the departmental contingency fund or raise the money through contributions from teachers and students. At times, it becomes a problem to raise adequate funds for such visits, as a result of which they cannot always be held frequently. The Covid-19 Pandemic had affected the regularity of such visits, though most of the Departments have tried to revive the practice in the 2022-23 session. A designated fund allocated for educational tours and organising seminars/ symposia/ conferences/ workshops would definitely prove to be helpful in resolving this financial issue.





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Activities of the Research Advisory Council at a glance

- 1. Dissemination of information to faculty members regarding extramural funding opportunities and encouraging them to apply for the same both through workshops as well as through emails
- 2. Organization of seminars and conference for students, faculty members, and the broader scientific community
- 3. Organization of hands-on-training programmes, student seminars and peer-meet programmes dedicated towards student research.
- 4. Funding short term student research with seed money from DBT STAR College grant, assigning mentors and encouraging student publications out of those projects.
- 5. Monitoring the Central Instrumentation Facility and ensuring its adequate usage both by internal and external users with proper log book entry.
- 6. Augmentation of the Central Instrumentation Facility through purchase of new instruments including high end facilities for research use.
- 7. Arranging industry and institute visits for students as well as internship programmes to provide them with adequate exposure of industry environment as well as acquaint them with the research ambience prevailing at the top-notch research institutions.
- 8. Mediating research collaborations with premier research institutions like Indian Institute of Technology and Indian Institute of Science Education and Research.
- 9. Mediating linkages and tie-ups with industries to facilitate potential job opportunities for students.

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Resolution of Research Committee meeting held on 9th July 2018

- Formation of IEC is important part of the project under discussion. Principal Investigator (PI) should strictly adhere the IEC guidelines of the ICMR, mentioning clearly the individual positions (philosopher, clinician, legal expert, lay person, medical person etc.). An approval of the said ethical committee from ICMR is required prior to the implementation of the project at this college.
- It appears from the guideline that the chairperson of the proposed IEC should be appointed from outside the Institution and not the head of the same institution (Page 9, ICMR Guideline).
- Before constituting the IEC, the PI should procure the individual consent letter of the person concerned whose name will be proposed for the IEC and submitted to appropriate authority.
- 4. No member of the Research Committee will be the member of the proposed IEC.
- 5. PI has enclosed the composition of the previous IEC committee formed in 2013 during his tenure at Bidhannagar College and during submission of this proposal. It is expected and advisable that PI must have a clearance certificate from the appropriate authority (ICMR) in the mean time mentioning clearly the number of the said IEC approved committee.
- It is expected that Co investigator of the proposed project should not be the member of the proposed IEC committee.
- PI should clear and clarify the terms and regulations regarding the duration of the sanctioned project as well as his date of superannuation.
- 8. No CV of Co PI was found in the project proposal. Co PI is requested to submit his CV
- It is noted that the project samples will come from human beings and NRS medical college has their own IEC code number. Committee members opined that the sample collection of the project may be carried out in collaboration of the NRS Medical College.

10. Research committee has appreciated the significance / importance of the project but requested the PI to comply the above noted points at an early date and place the revised papers for speedy implementation of the project.



- 4. Special drive will be taken to boost the teachers to go for research publication and apply for extramural projects, in this regard, a special seminar will be organized by the committee to inform the faculty members about the prospective funding agencies.
- Initiative will be taken to organize seminars/workshops/hands-on-training programmes on Research Methodology and IPR as also other extension activities under the purview of NSS.
- Efforts will be taken to initiate new MOU for academic activities and also to conduct activities under the existing MOU.
- 7. Faculty members will be encouraged to take student interns from other institutions to foster collaborative activities. For this, students have to apply from their Institutions through proper channel to the concerned faculty member of the college. These applications will then be assessed and forwarded through the Committee and IQAC of the college for final approval by Principal.
- 8. Current year students from UG 4th and 6th Semester and PG 4th Semester achieving outstanding performance in academic and co-curricular activities will be awarded with certificate of appreciation and cash prize. In this respect, different departments have been already asked to nominate their students vide notice from Office of the Principal dated 21th June, 2023. Final Selection will be done by the committee and the IQAC of the college. Unless exceptional circumstances arise, the number of awardees from each Dept. will be limited to two.
